**\*\*Is it a Cold...or ?**

Cold and flu season has arrived, and we're seeing higher absence rates due to illness. The common cold can make us feel pretty miserable with slight fever, sneezing, productive cough, and sore throat. Colds usually clear up within a couple of weeks, especially if you drink extra fluids and rest.

Influenza, pneumonia, and whooping cough (pertussis) cause much more serious symptoms and some that are different from colds. Typical influenza symptoms include high fever, severe headache, and extreme fatigue and body aches. With pneumonia and whooping cough there usually are symptoms like a cold, but they're much more severe and last longer. See your doctor if you have any of these more serious symptoms.

You can slow the spread of all of these illnesses by washing your hands (remember, we live in WASHYOURHANDSington!) and staying home until your fever has been gone for 24 hours. And if you haven't gotten a flu shot yet, it's not too late; check with the health department or your doctor for an appointment. While you're at it, find out if you need a tetanus booster (it includes vaccine for pertussis).
